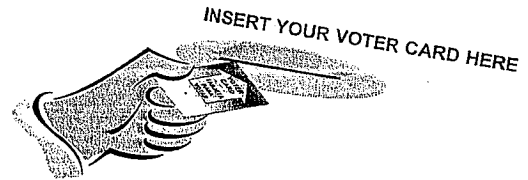


TOUCH-SCREEN VOTING

INSERT your **VOTER CARD** into the bright yellow slot located at the bottom left of the voting machine. Push it all the way in until you feel it "click."

TOUCH anywhere in the box that contains the name of the candidate of your choice. Confirm that a green check mark appears in the circle located in the box in which your choice appears.

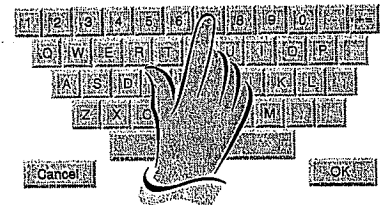
YOU MAY CHANGE your vote by touching the same selection again. The candidate is unselected and all circles for that contest appear again.

WRITE-IN the name of a qualified candidate by touching **WRITE-IN** on the candidate list. When the on-screen keyboard appears, key in the candidate's name, then touch **OK**. The write-in candidate's name now appears on the list of candidates.



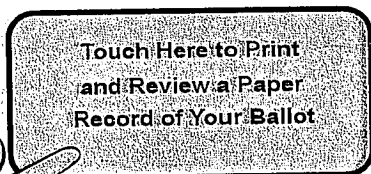
