

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS WHO ARE VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

To vote for a candidate whose name appears on the ballot, CONNECT THE HEAD AND TAIL OF THE ARROW THAT POINTS to the right of the candidate's name. Where two or more candidates for the same office are to be elected, CONNECT THE HEAD AND THE TAIL OF THE ARROW THAT POINTS to the right of the names of all candidates for the office for whom you desire to vote – not to exceed the number of candidates to be elected.

To vote for a candidate for Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Presiding Justice, Court of Appeal; or Associate Justice, Court of Appeal, CONNECT THE HEAD AND TAIL OF THE ARROW after the word "YES." To vote against that candidate, CONNECT THE HEAD AND TAIL OF THE ARROW after the word "NO."

To vote for a "qualified" write-in candidate, write in the person's name in the blank space provided for that purpose after the names of the other candidates for the same office and CONNECT THE HEAD AND TAIL OF THE ARROW THAT POINTS to the right of the name you have written in, or your vote will not be counted.

To vote on any proposition or measure, CONNECT THE HEAD AND TAIL OF THE ARROW THAT POINTS to the word "YES" or the word "NO".

All distinguishing marks or erasures are forbidden and make the ballot void. If you wrongly mark, tear or deface any portion of your ballot – write 'SPOILED' on the ballot card(s) and bring to the Elections Office at 981 H Street, Suite 160 and obtain another ballot to vote.

AFTER YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING, retain the numbered stub and place ballot card(s) in your return envelope – SIGN YOUR NAME & PRINT YOUR RESIDENCE ADDRESS on the back of return envelope – then mail or deliver to the Elections Office.

TO VOTE

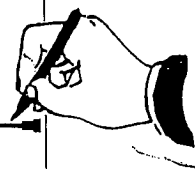
Use a pencil or dark ink pen.

2. Do not use magic marker or permanent ink marking pen.

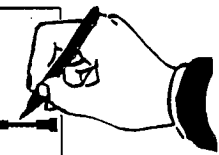
